
- Hem the top and bottom of the Slip Pockets
- 2. On the **Slip Pockets** set the logos, reflective tape, and press pass pocket with MFG tag on the back
- 3. Top stitch #10 zipper to the top. Add 2 zipper slides




wrong side

Hem + 3/4"Hook

- Set the Slip Pockets on the Out Side Pocket on marks. Making sure the pocket with the press pass window is on the Front Pocket.
- 5. **Hem** the top and bottom of the gray Parapac **Back 3 Pockets.**
- Set Back 3 Pockets on the Back Out Side Pocket folding on the marks to make the pocket puffy.
- Hem Out Side Pocket where it is clip in and run 3/4" hook on the inside
- 8. On the wrong side marks run 3/4" loop on the wrong side.
- Fold the Out Side Pocket in half and baste.
 Sew under the slip pocket and sew in the Bottom Pocket foam.






- 10. Hem Inner Zip Facing on side with no markes
- 11. Hem Outer Zip Facing on both sides
- 12. Inner and Back Front Pockets get <u>handles</u> set with the automatic machine
- 13. Set the zipper on the **Zipper Facing** with two #10 zipper slides
- 14. Z-tack 1/2" X 6" webbing on the zipper facing on marks
- 15. Set the zipper and Facing on the Out Side Pocket










- 16. Hem all around the gray Parapac Front 1 pocket
- 17. Front Inner Pockets gets the Parapac Front 1 pocket set on folding at marks so the pocket is puffy.
- 18. Set the 2" elastic on Front Inner Pockets.Hem the ends of the elastic and sew down on the mark. The elastic should be puffy and have lots of space like 3 5 fingers.
- 19. Set the 1" elastic on **Back Inner Pockets Hem** the ends of the elastic and sew down on the mark. The elastic should be puffy and can easily fit a fingers width.



20. Finally set the pocket on the Inner Pockets making sure the bottom marks match – one center mark are Front patterns two bottom marks are Back patterns

Divider


2" Hook folded in seam



1 1/2" Loop

21. Divider gets folded in half, stick 2" Hook into the seam. Flip right side out and stuff the corrugated Plastic finishing it with a top stitch closed.

- 22. Both Inners get 3/4" Loop run on top
- 23. Inner Back gets 1 1/2" loop on marks
- 24. Inner Front gets the divider top stitched on to marks
- 25. Baste the inner and the fronts together leaving the top open-
- 26. Nicely done! Moving on



top

- Take the 3/4" X 6" webbing and loop it thought the one zipper slides. The slide should be about 4" apart. Baste the raw edges of the webbing to its self so the zipper sild on its own loop.
- 2. Take the **Vinyl Handle** cover and lay it on reflective tape. Hem the vinyl around the tape. You can leave a shorter side raw
- 3. Rap the handle around the webbing with the slides on it. Sew it in place



- Fold the top in half and Hem the long sides, top stitch zipper
- 5. **Hem** one side of **Zipper Tape** and top stitch it to the zipper
- 6. But the Zipper slide on
- Seam Cover Tab To Top Flap, matching Marks, Then hem setting 1 1/2" Loop





Top Flap

- 1. Hem the Inner Flaps with 3/4 hook
- Take the Top and Sides and Inner Sided and sew together, right side of Sides and Inner Sides face each other with the Top sandwiched in. make sure to back tack over the zipper and burn and trim it
- Flip the sides and baste them together leaving the bottom open for stuffing later. Top stitching the top down
- Sew the slip not dot on the bottom maks sure the bottom makes are facing the front/back properly
- 5. Sew the **Front** and **Back** making sure you keep your 3/8 seam allowence.
- 6. Sew the **Inner Flaps** in covering the raw edges
- 7. Stuff the sides sew the foam in and flip
- 8. Woza your done go give your self a break!
